Top of these three passes are also known as vantage points for spectacular mountain views of Mt. Everest 8848 m, Mt. Cho-Oyo 8,201 m, (Sixth highest mountain on the planet), Mt. Makalu 8,481 m, Mt. Amadablam 6,812 m, Mt. Lhotse 8,516 m and other major mountain panorama. Adds further pleasure to the trekkers with the view of the glaciers like Ngozumpa glacier, Khumbu glacier etc and view of Gokyo valley and Gokyo Lake from the passes.
