



Three Pass, Everest BC and Island 6,189m



Introduction

Everest Three high passes trekking with Island Peak 6189m Climbing route has an itinerary for those who want to experience the challenges of world's highest passes, Renjo-La Pass (5446m/17520ft), Cho-La Pass (5420m/17782ft), Kongma-La Pass (5535m/18,159ft) including Gokyo Valley and Gokyo Fifth Lake safari it's adventure experience of lifetime mountain trails. Leading through Sherpa villages where unique customs and cultures can be closely observed while passing through the monuments, Buddhist Monasteries, Prayer wheels and flags. The routes offer the best mountain closeup mountain view of above 8000m and many others of lower heights like Kusum Kanguru 6367m, Taboche 6542m, Ama Dablam 6812m, Pumori 7161m, Cholatse 6440m, Khumbutse 6636m, Baruntse 7129m, Kangtega 6782m, Nuptse 7861m, Lhotse 8516m and many other numerous high himalayan peaks including Mount Everest 8848m .

At Sagarmatha National Park in the trail, which is a habitat of rare flora and fauna, the uniqueness of Himalayan survival can be understood. The spectacular wildlife one can encounter in their wild habitat include Himalaya Thar, Barking Deer, Musk Deer, Blue Sheep, Blood Pheasant, Tibetan Snow Cock, Crimson Horned Pheasant, Yak etc....

Island Peak (6,189m/20,305ft) lies in the mid-central of the higher Chukhung valley resembling an island standing proud in the sea of ice. There is no doubt that Himalayan peaks have drawn adventurers, climbers and cultural enthusiasts for many decades. Among all the trekking peaks in Nepal, Island peak is the most popular as it is suitable to all novice

climbers and experienced trekkers. Which is also well known as Imja Tse. It offers an exhilarating climbing experience beyond simply trekking in Nepal with hike to Everest base camp. Climbing the Island peak, you will stand on a summit of wonderful mountain at 6,189 meters with almost the same unforgettable sense of achievement as you would on the top of mt. Everest.

The Island Peak is the most chosen climbing peak as this peak was training exercise for Edmund Hillary and Tenzing Norgay who were the first climbers of this peak. is one of the main climbing peaks in the Everest Region of Nepal with an impressive and highly glaciated West Face that rises from the Lhotse Glacier. The Island peak climbing is physically demanding but not technically challenging.

Everest Three High Passes Trekking with Island Peak 6189m Peak Climbing starts with the flight from Kathmandu-Lukla which is well known as gateway to the land of Sherpa and Mount Everest. Like most treks in the region. We then make our way up to Namche Bazaar where we will keep continuing the Everest Three Passes Trail with Magnificent views along the way.

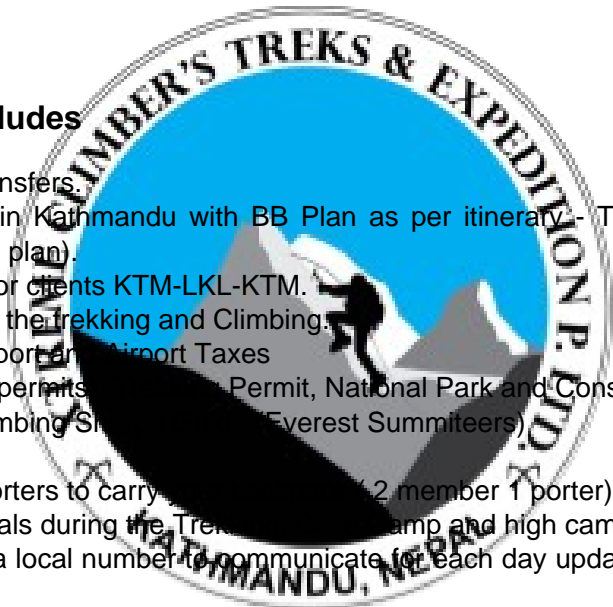
- **Day 12** : Trek to Gorakshap 5,160m, 5-6 hrs walk Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 13** : Trek to Everest Base Camp 5,357m and return to Lobuche for overnight. 6 to 7 hrs Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 14** : Lobuche - Kongma La 5,535m - Chhukung 4,730m: 8-10 hrs [3rd High Passes] Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 15** : Chhukung to Island Peak Base camp: 5,200m Tented Camp. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 16** : Base Camp summit push over Island Peak 6189m and back to Chhukung Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 17** : Chhukung to Phortse 3878m. 6-7 hours. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 18** : Phortse to Monjo 2835m. 6-7 hours. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner

Cost and payment details

The cost is depending on group size, affected due to the requirement of number of guides and porters, requisite of Hotel in Kathmandu, method of land/air transport. The itinerary is changeable and modifiable as per needs and time frame of trekkers. Cost will be re calculated if the itinerary is changed or modified. Why we don't include cost in our website?

NOTE: To provide you service in reasonable cost and attempt to address your each requirement **Xtreme Climbers** desired to provide you with some information which directly affects the cost and also helps us breakdown the cost. That is why we have decided to clarify our customers that due to the following reasons mentioned below we have not included the cost of each package in the company website.

1. Climbing season: The climbing permit royalty cost for mountain will be different during Spring and Autumn season. Normally most of the climbers climbs Himalayas in the Spring season. Climbing permit during Autumn will be 50% less than the spring season.
2. The cost of the trip depends on Number of persons joining in group for High expedition or Mountain Climbing including number of climbers, non-climber, base camp supporters, medical doctors, The number of climbing Sherpa guides, high altitude porters, kitchen crew, mode of transport you prefer and many other factors can affect the cost of the trip. Alpine climbing guide as well as the category of the hotel accommodation and the facilities that you aspire in the mountains affect the cost.
3. We operate the High Expeditions, Peak Climbing in full arrangement package and basic arrangement service (full board or base camp service) which directly affects the expedition cost.
4. Request numbers of oxygen, mask regulators and the brands the clients require
5. The itinerary may be changed after reaching an understanding between the agency and the client. Other activities could be added or reduced as per the client's request before processing the trip. Price for reduced activities could be deducted and additional activities could be added in mutual understanding.
6. Either you want to operate this expedition as international group joining basics of Xtreme Climbers or individual (private arrangement) expedition.
7. Type of high camp food that you require. Any specialized food that has to be ordered from foreign countries will be costlier compared to the food available here.
8. Either any of the climbers intend to set any world records? If so, do they require special services or equipment?
