



## Ski Ama-Dablam



### Introduction

Ama Dablam 6,856m (22,494ft) world's one of the most impressive peak to climb. Due to its unique, sharply pointed soaring shape Ama Dalam also known as (Matterhorn of Nepal Himalayas) Climbing Ama dablam offers the most superb, technical climbing experience in the Himalayas. ascending this sheer peak is the ultimate dream of climbers. Located in the heart of Everest's Khumbu region, it lies directly above Tengboche Monastery on the well-worn path to Everest Base Camp. Admired by thousands of Climbers and trekkers every year. From the summit it offers the impeachable summit panoramic views of Mt. Everest, Lhotse, Cho Oyu, Makalu and many more Himalayan peaks. If you have good previous climbing experience and wish to participate fully as a team member of an expertly led expedition. Then Ama Dablam expeditions provide the ultimate challenge to the world's most technical peak climb.

The standard and most popular ascent to Ama Dablam is via South-Western Ridge, the same route followed by Gill (NZ) Ward (UK), and Bishop (USA) in the first ascent of the Ama Dablam in 1961. The route offers a varied and sustained climb with a reasonable level of difficulty. Three high camps are set up at strategic points. The climb is moderate up to Camp 1, then it gets challenging up along the narrow granite ridge. Negotiating pitches of steep ice and snow slopes, the route gets more technical from Camp 2. From Camp 3, skirt around the hanging glacier or the Dablam, cross snow (A sharp ridge) and bergschrund (A gap or crevasse at the edge) between ice cliffs, and scale the summit.

- **Day 1 :** Arrive at Tribhuvan International Airport (KTM) Kathmandu: Arrival in Kathmandu [1300 m/4264 ft] Arrive at any time, Xtreme Climbers vehicle and represent we'll pick you up from Tribhuvan International Airport and take you to the hotel. Your included activities consist of refreshments, introduction to your guide, as well as an introduction on The Trek. Meal includes:Breakfast/Dinner

- **Day 3 :** Fly to Lukla (2,800m/9,184ft) then trek to Phakding (2,652m/8,700ft): 40 min flight, 3 hours trek. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 4 :** Phakding to Namche Bazaar (3,440m/11,283ft): 5-6 hours. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 5 :** Namche Bazaar (3,440 m/11,283 ft): acclimatization. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 6 :** Namche Bazaar to Debuche. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 7 :** Debuche to Pheriche (4,300m/14,107ft): 5-6 hours. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 8 :** Acclimatization. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 9 :** Pheriche to Ama Dablam Base Camp (4570m/15000 ft): 5-6 hours. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 10 :** Acclimatization and Pre-climb training at Ama Dablam Base Camp. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 11 :** Ascending and Descending of Ama Dablam (6856m/22488ft). Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 12 :** Trek to Phortse. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 13 :** Phortse explore LuniGo Peak 5212m. Pleasant evening. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 14 :** Phortse to Lukla. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 15 :** Fly back to Kathmandu Leisure day and farewell dinner in Kathmandu. Included meals:Breakfast Dinner
- **Day 16 :** Final Departure back to hometown. Included meals:Breakfast

## Cost and payment details

The cost is depending on group size, affected due to the requirement of number of guides and porters, requisite of Hotel in Kathmandu, method of land/air transport. The itinerary is changeable and modifiable as per needs and time frame of trekkers. Cost will be re calculated if the itinerary is changed or modified. ## Why we don't include cost in our website?

**NOTE:** To provide you service in reasonable cost and attempt to address your each requirement **Xtreme Climbers** desired to provide you with some information which directly affects the cost and also helps us breakdown the cost. That is why we have decided to clarify our customers that due to the following reasons mentioned below we have not included the cost of each package in the company website.

1. Climbing season: The climbing permit royalty cost for mountain will be different during Spring and Autumn season. Normally most of the climbers climbs Himalayas in the Spring season. Climbing permit during Autumn will be 50% less than the spring season.
2. The cost of the trip depends on the number of persons joining in group for High expedition or Mountain Climbing including number of climbers, porters, base camp supporters, medical doctors, The number of climbing Sherpa guides, high altitude porters, crew, mode of transport you prefer and many other factors can affect the cost of the trip. Alpine climbing is not in the category of the hotel accommodation and the facilities that you aspire in the mountains affect the cost.
3. We operate the High Expeditions, Peak Climbing in full arrangement package and basic arrangement service (full board or base camp service) which directly affects the expedition cost.
4. Request numbers of oxygen, mask regulators and the brands the clients require
5. The itinerary may be changed after reaching an understanding between the agency and the client. Other activities could be added or reduced as per the client's request before processing the trip. Price for reduced activities could be deducted and additional activities could be added in mutual understanding.
6. Either you want to operate this expedition as international group joining basics of Xtreme Climbers or individual (private arrangement) expedition.
7. Type of high camp food that clients require. Any specialized food that has to be ordered from foreign countries will be costlier compared to the one available here.
8. Either any of the climbers intend to attempt any world records? If so, do they require special services or

equipment?
