



Nirekha Peak 6189m



Introduction

Nirekha Peak Climbing is newly explored and opened for climbing. An exceptional mountain adventure for those who seek a new explorer and wish to be completely close to the untouched beauty of nature Himalayas. Close to the Tibetan border and hidden among the well-known giants of Mt. Everest, Mt. Cho Oyu, and Cholatse. Our expedition begins from Kathmandu with a flight to Lukla 2860m "Gateway to Everest" and "Entrance to the Land of Sherpa" begins trekking from there and trekking through the famous 'Khumbu' region The cultural heartland of "The Famous Sherpas". We will reach the base camp of Nirekha Peak after crossing through the famous Cho-La Pass at 5368 m. Nirekha is located in the same chain as the Lobuche summits, just E of the Cho La Col (not to be confused with the famous Cho-La pass 5368m that is only a few hundred meters away). The normal ascent to the Nirekha Peak is a great and - depending on the conditions-difficult climb, at difficulty AD+/D-. Only experienced climbers should attempt this route, The ascent is mostly in ice and snow, though it is partially saved with fixed ropes. The summit consists of two summit pyramids. It is unclear which one is higher. The north summit is easier but requires to cross a difficult crevasse, while the south summit requires one pitch in steep 50° ice. From the summit of Nirekha Peak, we will have the magnificent views of the greatest Himalayan range of Mt. Everest 8848m, Mt. Nuptse 7861m, Mt. Lhotse 8516m, Mt. Mt. Pumori 7161m, Ama Dablam 6812m, Cholatse 6440m, Tawache 6542m and other surrounding Himalayas ranges.

Itinerary

- **Day 1 :** Arrive at Tribhuvan International Airport (KTM) Kathmandu: Arrival in Kathmandu [1300 m/4264 ft] Arrive at any time, Xtreme Climbers vehicle and represent we'll pick you up from Tribhuvan International Airport and take you to the hotel. Your included activities consist of 4 elements, introduction to your guide, as well as an introduction on The Trek. Meal includes:Breakfast
- **Day 2 :** Free Day in Kathmandu and Preparation for trek & climbing Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 3 :** Fly to Lukla 2,800m & Trek to Phakding 2,652m, 3-4 hrs walk Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 4 :** Phakding to Namche Bazaar 3,440m, 6-7 hrs walk Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 5 :** Acclimatization day at Namche Bazaar Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 6 :** Trek to Tengboche or Deboche (3870m/12693ft), 5 hours walk. Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 7 :** Trek to Dingboche (4410m/14465ft), 5 hours of walking. Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 8 :** Dingboche- Rest Day, (4410m/14465ft) 2/3 hours of acclimatization Hike. Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 9 :** Trek to Lobuche (4910m/16105ft) 5 to 6 hours of walking. Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 10 :** Trek to Gorak Shep (5120m/16800ft) and then to Everest Base Camp (5364m) and back to Gorak Shep 5/6 hours. Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 11 :** Trek to Kala Pattar 5550m (18200ft) and back to Periche 4240m (4910m/16105ft) 6 hours of Walking. Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 12 :** Dzongla to Nirekha Base Camp (4950m) via Cho La pass (5368m): 6 hours of walking. Meal Includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 13 :** Nirekha Peak High Camp (5368m) 3-4 hrs or walking: rest and basic climbing training. Meal Includes:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 14 :** Summit Nirekha Peak (6159 m/20201 ft) and back to Base Camp: 10 - 11 hours Meal Includes:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 15 :** Nirekha Base Camp to Gokyo Lakes (4,800m): 4 hours. Meal Includes :Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 16 :** Gokyo to Machermo (4,470m): 5-6 hours. Meal Included:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 17 :** Machhermo to Phortse Village 2878m. 6/7 Hours. Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 18 :** Phortse to Monjo 2825m 5 hours of walking. Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner.
- **Day 19 :** Monjo to Lukla 2840m. Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner.
- **Day 20 :** Fly to Kathmandu (1350m/4428 ft), 35 minute flight. Meal includes:Breakfast/Dinner.
- **Day 21 :** Departure day from Kathmandu (1,264m). Today your trip comes at the end. After breakfast at your hotel, you now have free time . If it is the day that you fly back home/ onward to your travel destination, we will transfer you to the airport on time. Or you could extend your stay or you may get our assistance for additional activities that you are interested in. Meal includes:Breakfast

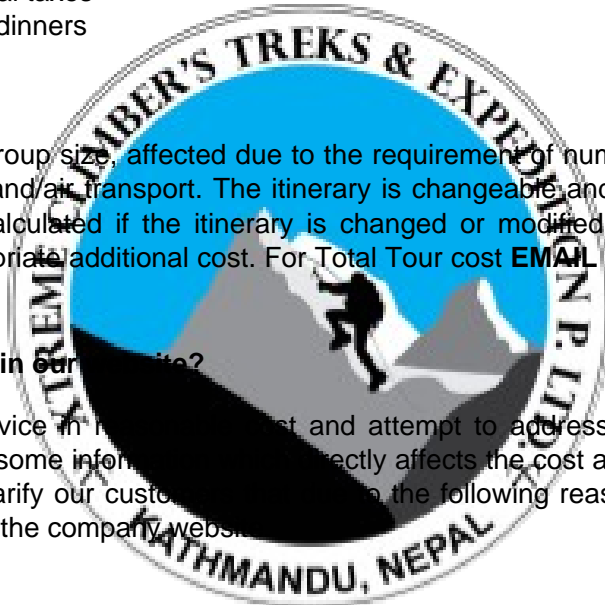
Cost and payment details

The cost is depending on group size, affected due to the requirement of number of guides and porters, requisite of Hotel in Kathmandu, method of land/air transport. The itinerary is changeable and modifiable as per needs and time frame of trekkers. Cost will be re calculated if the itinerary is changed or modified. Additional activities may be added as per trekkers request with appropriate additional cost. For Total Tour cost **EMAIL US**, we will send you within 24 hours as your requirements.

Why we don't include cost in our website?

NOTE: To provide you service in Nepal, we try to address your each requirement **Xtreme Climbers** desired to provide you with some information which directly affects the cost and also helps us breakdown the cost. That is why we have decided to clarify our customer. In the following reasons mentioned below we have not included the cost of each package in the company website.

1. Climbing season: The climbing permit royalty cost for mountain will be different during Spring and Autumn season. Normally most of the climbers climbs Himalayas in the Spring season. Climbing permit during Autumn will be 50% less than the spring season.
2. The cost of the trip depends on Number of persons joining in group for High expedition or Mountain Climbing including number of climbers, non-climber, base camp supporters, medical doctors, The number of climbing Sherpa guides, high altitude porters, kitchen crew, mode of transport you prefer and many other factors can affect the cost of the trip. Alpine climbing guide as well as the category of the hotel accommodation and the facilities that you aspire in the mountains affect the cost.
3. We operate the High Expeditions, Peak Climbing in full arrangement package and basic arrangement service (full board or base camp service) which directly affects the expedition cost.
4. Request numbers of oxygen, mask regulators and the brands the clients require
5. The itinerary may be changed after reaching an understanding between the agency and the client. Other activities



could be added or reduced as per the client's request before processing the trip. Price for reduced activities could be deducted and additional activities could be added in mutual understanding.

6. Either you want to operate this expedition as international group joining basics of Xtreme Climbers or individual (private arrangement) expedition.
7. Type of high camp food that clients require. Any specialized food that has to be ordered from foreign countries will be costlier compared to the one available here.
8. Either any of the climbers intend to attempt any world records? If so, do they require special services or equipment?
