



Langshisha Ri (6427m)



Introduction

Langshisha Ri Peak Climbing Trip takes you to the majestic Langtang region of the Himalaya. This wonderful peak climbing adventure is one of the most adventurously beautiful climbing trips in Langtang region. Starting trip from Syabrubesi (1462m) and follows the en route to Lama Hotel (2500m), Langtang Village (3,307m) and Kyanjing Gompa (3,798m). Thereafter, we take a hike to Langshisha Kharka (3850m), arriving at Langshisha Base Camp (4,325m). From there we ascend Langshisha High Camp (5,310m). After a short climbing rehearsal, we climb Langshisha Ri Peak (6,427m).

Langtang trekking route crossing through the Langtang Valley, which offers you the views of beautiful Pine forest, through the rugged rock and swift mountain streams including the snow-capped peaks. During this trip you get a chance to explore the majestic charm of Langtang valley. The adventure trek that takes you to the peak through Langtang valley and Kyanjing Gompa lets you enjoy the Natural, Spiritual and the rich Culture of the region. By reaching Kyanjing Gompa, you will also have chance to explore the one of the oldest Buddhist monastery and also hike to Tserko Ri standing 5,000 meters above sea level.

After successful climbing of Langshisha Ri Peak, we climb down to Langshisha Ri Base Camp (4,325m). Then we trace back to Kyanjing Gompa (3,798m), Lama Hotel (2500m), and Syabru Bensi (1462m), arriving at Kathmandu (1164m), bringing the trekking to an end.

Itinerary

- **Day 1** : Arrive at Tribhuvan International Airport (KTM) Kathmandu. Arrival in Kathmandu [1300 m/4264 ft]
- **Day 2** : preparation day for climbing and Sightseeing tour in Kathmandu. Included meals:Breakfast Dinner
- **Day 3** : Kathmandu to Syabru Besi [1400m], 5-9 hours, Overnight Hotel. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 4** : Syabru Besi to Lama Hotel [2748m], 5/6 hours, Overnight Lodge. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 5** : Trek to Langtang village [3500m], 4/5 hours, Overnight Lodge. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 6** : Trek to Kyagjin [3800m], 4/5 hours, Overnight Lodge. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 7** : Rest day in Kyanjin Gumpa. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 8** : Kyanjing Gompa to Langsisa Kharka, overnight tented camp. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 9** : Langsisa Kharka to Langsisa high altitude tented camp. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 10** : Base Camp to Langsisa high altitude tented camp. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 11** : Summit up to Langsisa Ri and back to base camp, overnight camp. Included meals:Breakfast Pack Lunch Dinner
- **Day 12** : Spare Day for climbing, overnight camp. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 13** : Trek back to Kyanjin Gumpa, overnight lodge. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 14** : Kyanjing Gumpa to Lama Hotel, Trek down to Lama Hotel same way return, overnight in lodge. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 15** : Lama Hotel to Syabru Bensi same way return trekking back to Syabru Bensi. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 16** : Syabru Bensi to Kathmandu by Jeep or Bus it will be about 6 to 8 hour drive back to Kathmandu, overnight Hotel. Farewell Dinner by evening time with traditional Dance and Food. Included meals:Breakfast Lunch Dinner
- **Day 17** : Final Departure

Cost and payment details

The cost is depending on group size, affected due to the requirement of number of guides and porters, requisite of Hotel in Kathmandu, method of land/air transport. The itinerary is changeable and modifiable as per needs and time frame of trekkers. Cost will be re calculated if the itinerary is changed or modified. Why we don't include cost in our website?

NOTE: To provide you service in reasonable cost and attempt to address your each requirement **Xtreme Climbers** desired to provide you with some information which directly affects the cost and also helps us breakdown the cost. That is why we have decided to clarify our cost that due to the following reasons mentioned below we have not included the cost of each package in the complete price.

1. Climbing season: The climbing permit royalty for mountain will be different during Spring and Autumn season. Normally most of the climbers climbs Himalayas in the Spring season. Climbing permit during Autumn will be 50% less than the spring season.
2. The cost of the trip depends on Number of persons joining in group for High expedition or Mountain Climbing including number of climbers, non-climber, base camp supporters, medical doctors, The number of climbing Sherpa guides, high altitude porters, kitchen crew, mode of transport you prefer and many other factors can affect the cost of the trip. Alpine climbing guide as well as the category of the hotel accommodation and the facilities that you aspire in the mountains affect the cost.
3. We operate the High Expeditions, Peak Climbing in full arrangement package and basic arrangement service (full board or base camp service) which directly affects the expedition cost.
4. Request numbers of oxygen, mask regulators and the brands the clients require
5. The itinerary may be changed after reaching an understanding between the agency and the client. Other activities could be added or reduced as per the client's request before processing the trip. Price for reduced activities could be deducted and additional activities could be added in mutual understanding.
