



Kanchenjunga Base Camp



Introduction

Xtreme Climbers Kanchenjunga Base Camp trekking, a wonderful and mind blowing adventure probably the one and only trek that leads you to visit both South and North base camps of the same mountains in one single adventure around whole Himalaya range. Kanchenjunga base camp trekking, leads you to spectacular country around far eastern Himalaya of Nepal within the shade of mighty Khumbakarna Himalaya range of mountains where world 3rd highest Mt. Kanchenjunga at 8,586 m / 28,169 ft high located and straddles the border between Nepal and Sikkim (a small state of North East India).

Kanchenjunga actually known by its local native name as “Kanchendzonga” of Tibetan origin language, meaning a mountain with five Jewels which stands towering as Nepal second highest peaks.

First ascent of Mt. Kanchenjunga in 1955 by British Expeditions led by late Sir George Band using the South route near Yarlung glacier.

A fascinating adventure to Kanchenjunga base camps with variations of landscapes and scenery during the long walks within high hills villages of Kirat tribes known as Rai and Limbu and further higher where Sherpa and Bhotia people resides. Our adventure begins with flight to low land of eastern Nepal and then heading higher cooler alpine areas through lovely Ilam town and villages with huge wide tea gardens to reach our starting point of trekking at Sukhetar.

Walk leads first visiting Kanchenjunga South base camp through remote farm villages and dense deep forest and towards Yarlung glacier filled with moraine, ice and then heading towards further north with super views of Mt. Janu and other peaks of Kanchenjunga range. Slowly our enters an arid dry country reaching at Pang-Pema at 5,065 m high within Kanchenjunga North Base Camp, here with time to explore the isolated and beautiful mountainous area facing massive fields of ice and glaciers, then heading back on an alternative route to reach at Sukhetar and Ilam for the drive back to Bhadrapur, where a scenic flight brings you at Kathmandu after a magnificent adventure on Kanchenjunga base camp trekking.

- **Day 1** : Arrival in Kathmandu Airport: Arrival in Kathmandu [1300 m/4264 ft]
- **Day 2** : Flight Kathmandu to Bhadrapur (45 min) — Drive to Ilam (3-4 hours). Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 3** : Drive from Ilam to Taplejung (7 hours). Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 4** : Trek from Taplejung — Chule (921 m) 5-6 hours Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 5** : Trek from Mitlung — Chule (921 m) 5-6 hours Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 6** : Trek from Chiruwa — Sukhetar (3595 m) 5 hours Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 7** : Trek from Sukhetar — Amjilosa (3595 m) 6 hours Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 8** : Trek from Amjilosa — Gyabla (3595 m) 5 hours Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner

- **Day 16** : Trek from High Camp - Tseram (3870 m) - 8 hours Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 17** : Trek from Tseram — Ramche (4580 m) 6-7 hours Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 18** : Explore to Yalung Base Camp (4500 m) 7-8 hours Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 19** : Trek from Ramche - Anda Phedi (3390 m) 5 hours Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 20** : Trek from Anda Phedi — Tortong (2995 m) 5 hours Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 21** : Trek from Tortong — Yamphudim (2080 m) 5-6 hours Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 22** : Trek from Yamphudim — Khebang (1915 m) 5 -6 hours Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 23** : Trek from Kheband to Khanidingbe and Overnight in Home-Stay/Lodge. Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 24** : Drive Khanidingbe to Birtamod by jeep Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 25** : Morning drive to Bhadrapur airport and flight back to Kathmandu and transfer to Hotel. Meal includes:Breakfast/Dinner
- **Day 26** : Final Departure

Cost and payment details

The cost is depending on group size, affected due to the requirement of number of guides and porters, requisite of Hotel in Kathmandu, method of land/air transport. The itinerary is changeable and modifiable as per needs and time frame of trekkers. Cost will be re calculated if the itinerary is changed or modified. Why we don't include cost in our website?

NOTE: To provide you service in reasonable cost and attempt to address your each requirement **Xtreme Climbers** desired to provide you with some information which directly affects the cost and also helps us breakdown the cost. That is why we have decided to clarify our cost that due to the following reasons mentioned below we have not included the cost of each package in the complete cost.

1. Climbing season: The climbing permit required for mountain will be different during Spring and Autumn season. Normally most of the climbers climb Himalayas in the Spring season. Climbing permit during Autumn will be 50% less than the spring season.
2. The cost of the trip depends on Number of persons joining in group for High expedition or Mountain Climbing including number of climbers, non-climber, base camp supporters, medical doctors, The number of climbing Sherpa guides, high altitude porters, kitchen crew, mode of transport you prefer and many other factors can affect the cost of the trip. Alpine climbing guide as well as the category of the hotel accommodation and the facilities that you aspire in the mountains affect the cost.
3. We operate the High Expeditions, Peak Climbing in full arrangement package and basic arrangement service (full board or base camp service) which directly affects the expedition cost.
4. Request numbers of oxygen, mask regulators and the brands the clients require
