



## LuriGo Peak 5,212m Trek



### Introduction

Newly explored on 2016 by Conrad Anker (World recognize Athletics as well the former Captain of The North Face) and Panuru Sherpa (Mountain Guide, Chairman of Khumbu Climbing Center, KCC) known as "Hero of Everest" 15 Times Everest Summitter including many other 8000m. Mountains (For further details of him please do visit [www.conradanker.com](http://www.conradanker.com)) With help and support of locales of Phortse Village.

LuriGo 5,212m. Peak for the panoramic view of many exceptional mountains that are above 8000 meters together with Mt Everest (8,848m/29, 028ft), Lhotse (8,516 m/24,940 ft), Nuptse (7,855m/25,772 ft), Makalu (8,463m/27758ft), Pumori (7,161m/23488ft), Tharmarsarku (6,623m/21723ft), Mt. Amadablam (6,812m/22349.08ft) and many more.... This particular trek gives you eyeful views of mountain vistas and glaciers and follows the rather praised trekking direction through the Dudh Koshi to its source the Gokyo Lake which is to the west of the Everest Base Camp.

**NOTE:** Members joining to accomplish LuriGo Peak should have bit of knowledge of Climbing and usages of climbing gears

- **Day 1** : Arrive at Tribhuvan International Airport (KTM) Kathmandu.
- **Day 2** : KATHMANDU/LUKLA/CHUMOA 2,710m. 4-5 hours. Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner.
- **Day 3** : CHUMOA/NAMCHE BAZAAR 3,440m. 5-6 hours. Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner.
- **Day 4** : NAMCHE BAZAAR/SANASA 3,764m. 4-5 hours. Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner.
- **Day 5** : SANASA/PHORTSE 3,874m 4-5 hours. Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner.
- **Day 6** : Phortse-LuriGo (Hike up to LuriGo 5,212m) back to Phortse overnight. 6/7 hours. Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 7** : Phortse, Trek to Monjo via Namche Bazar. 6-7 hours of walking. Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 8** : Monjo, Trek to Lukla 2825m 4-5 hours of walking. Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner.
- **Day 9** : Fly to Kathmandu (1350m/4428 ft), 35 minute flight. Meal includes:Breakfast/Dinner.
- **Day 10** : Final Departure

The cost is depending on group size, affected due to the requirement of number of guides and porters, requisite of Hotel in Kathmandu, method of land/air transport. The itinerary is changeable and modifiable as per needs and time frame of trekkers. Cost will be re calculated if the itinerary is changed or modified. ## Why we don't include cost in our website?

**NOTE:** To provide you service in reasonable cost and attempt to address your each requirement **Xtreme Climbers** desired to provide you with some information which directly affects the cost and also helps us breakdown the cost. That is



why we have decided to clarify our customers that due to the following reasons mentioned below we have not included the cost of each package in the company website.

1. Climbing season: The climbing permit royalty cost for mountain will be different during Spring and Autumn season. Normally most of the climbers climb Himalayas in the Spring season. Climbing permit during Autumn will be 50% less than the spring season.
2. The cost of the trip depends on Number of persons joining in group for High expedition or Mountain Climbing including number of climbers, non-climber, base camp supporters, medical doctors, The number of climbing Sherpa guides, high altitude porters, kitchen crew, mode of transport you prefer and many other factors can affect the cost of the trip. Alpine climbing guide as well as the category of the hotel accommodation and the facilities that you aspire in the mountains affect the cost.
3. We operate the High Expeditions, Peak Climbing in full arrangement package and basic arrangement service (full board or base camp service) which directly affects the expedition cost.
4. Request numbers of oxygen, mask regulators and the brands the clients require
5. The itinerary may be changed after reaching an understanding between the agency and the client. Other activities could be added or reduced as per the client's request before processing the trip. Price for reduced activities could be deducted and additional activities could be added on mutual understanding.
6. Either you want to operate this expedition as international group joining basics of Xtreme Climbers or individual (private arrangement) expedition.
7. Type of high camp food that clients require. Any specialized food that has to be ordered from foreign countries will be costlier compared to the one available here.
8. Either any of the climbers attempt any world records? If so, do they require special services or equipment?
