Khayar Lake (Khopra Danda) Trek



Introduction

Khayar Lake, Off the beaten trail, on to the long, remote mountain ridges, through exposit forest and traditional villages. Annapurna region into the wild glacial areas below Annapurna South is demanding but well worth the effort. Khayar Lake trek is a beautiful trekking area with the mix of culture and excellent Mountain View. Beside the scenic extravaganza of the peaks, the warm hospitality of the Gurung people along the way. During Khayar Lake trek, we will enjoy the view of great Annapurna Himalayan range in the Annapurna area, sacred Khayar Lake (4,500.m) as well as the stunning Sunrise from the Ghorepani poon hill 3210m.

The trek heads towards Ghorepani via Swanta village and ends at Nayapul with the drive back to Pokhara/Kathmandu. uplifted by the views of Annapurna and Machhapuchhre, includes amazing landscapes and small ancient villages. As the trek goes further, we will trek towards Khopra ridge leaving behind the Annapurna Circuit route. After reaching Khopra ridge, we will reach out towards Khayer Lake (4,500m) which is the highest point of our trek.

- Climbing season: The climbing permit royalty cost for mountain will be different during Spring and Autumn season.
 Normally most of the climbers climbs Himalayas in the Spring season. Climbing permit during Autumn will be 50% less than the spring season.

The cost of the trip depends on Number of persons joining in group for High expedition or Mountain Climbing including number of climbers, non-climber, base camp supporters, medical doctors, The number of climbing Sherpa guides, high altitude porters, kitchen crew, mode of transport you prefer and many other factors can affect the cost of the trip.
