



## Bhairav Kunda Trek



### Introduction

Bhairav Kunda trekking starting from Jalbire, a small trading town accessible from Kathmandu by road. While trekking in this wilderness area one can observe the lifestyle of the local people, their culture, and tradition and immerse oneself in the beauty of nature. From the top ridge of Bhairab Kunda one can have a full glimpse of Rolwaling range, Jugal Himal and some of the Tibetan mountains as well.

Bhairab Kunda trekking named after a holy lake Bhairab which is lies to the north east of Kathmandu A newly explored and opened trekking route in Nepal. Bhairav Kunda is a holy lake named after lord Shiva the "Bhairav" particular form is "God of destruction destroying both good and evil" One of the sacred pilgrimage site for spiritualists; which is named after the destructive feature of Holy Lord Shiva. People believe that plunging yourself in this Kunda (lake) will take away your sins, therefore many Hindu and Buddhist devotees visit and pay homage to this holy lake. Except Bhairab lake there also lies another popular lake which is called Panch Pokhari. Both places are off the beaten path and the trekkers must be self sufficient with camping gear and Nepalese crews.

- **Day 1** : Arrive at Tribhuvan International Airport (KTM) Kathmandu
- **Day 2** : Drive to Jalbire (1,000m) - 5 Hrs Drive by bus. Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 3** : Trek from Jalbire to Chanaute (1,345m) - 4/5 Hrs Trek. Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 4** : Trek from Chanaute to Khani Gaun (2,010m) - 5/6 Hrs Trek. Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 5** : Khani village exploration day. Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 6** : Trek from Khani Gaun to Forest Camp (3,150m) - 6/7 Hrs Trek. Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 7** : Trek from Forest Camp to Pati (3,765m) - 5/6 Hrs Trek. Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 8** : Trek from Pati to Bhairav Kunda (4,250m) - 3/4 Hrs Trek. Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 9** : Trek from Bhairav Kunda to Sherpa Gaun (2,500m), After Sunrise view 6/7 Hrs Trek. Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 10** : Trek from Sherpa Gaun to Larcha (1,500m) and visit Hot spring (Kodari Taro pani) - 4/5 Hrs Trek. Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 11** : Drive Back to Kathmandu. Meal includes:Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner
- **Day 12** : Final Departure

## Why we don't include cost in our website?

**NOTE:** To provide you service in reasonable cost and attempt to address your each requirement **Xtreme Climbers** desired to provide you with some information which directly affects the cost and also helps us breakdown the cost. That is why we have decided to clarify our customers that due to the following reasons mentioned below we have not included the cost of each package in the company website.

1. Climbing season: The climbing permit royalty cost for mountain will be different during Spring and Autumn season. Normally most of the climbers climbs Himalayas in the Spring season. Climbing permit during Autumn will be 50% less than the spring season.
2. The cost of the trip depends on Number of persons joining in group for High expedition or Mountain Climbing including number of climbers, non-climber, base camp supporters, medical doctors, The number of climbing Sherpa guides, high altitude porters, kitchen crew, mode of transport you prefer and many other factors can affect the cost of the trip. Alpine climbing guide as well as the category of the hotel accommodation and the facilities that you aspire in the mountains affect the cost.
3. We operate the High Expeditions, Peak Climbing in full arrangement package and basic arrangement service (full board or base camp service) which directly affects the expedition cost.
4. Request numbers of oxygen, mask regulators and the brands the clients require
5. The itinerary may be changed after reaching an understanding between the agency and the client. Other activities could be added or reduced as per the client's request before processing the trip. Price for reduced activities could be deducted and additional activities could be added in mutual understanding.
6. Either you want to operate this expedition as international group joining basics of Xtreme Climbers or individual (private arrangement) expedition.
7. Type of high camp food that you require. Any specialized food that has to be ordered from foreign countries will be costlier compared to the food available here.
